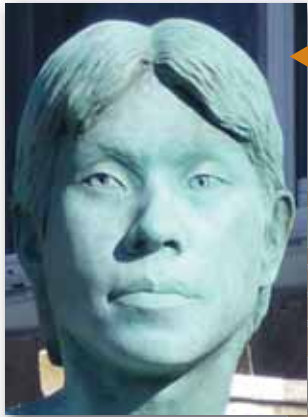

The Portrait Head

In this 9-week course, students will create a life-scale portrait head in clay, will make a mold from that sculpture and then will cast the head into a permanent material (hydrocal or similar) Armatures and clay

will be provided. A modest lab fee will cover casting materials.

Class limit: Minimum: 4, Maximum: 8
Cost: \$195 Materials Fee: \$35

Intro to Bronze Casting

Wait! It does get better than bending metal with fire... how about melting and pouring metal with fire!? The amazing process of lost wax casting is the focus of this class. Students will create a sculpture in wax and learn how to prepare it for the ceramic shell mold process. Students will be part of the burnout and bronze pour. Your final product will be a finished bronze sculpture.

Class Limit: Minimum: 3, Maximum: 8
Cost: \$475, plus individual expense for wax, metal, and certain finishing materials depending on amount used

Class meets: 3 hours per week for 9 weeks

Intro to Welding

What could be better than bending metal with fire? This course will teach students the basics of welding, with an emphasis on the use of the oxy-acetylene torch. It will also cover basic MIG welding and the use of shop tools required for cutting and shaping metal. Students will learn how to braze, weld, cut and shape metal. They will also be instructed in good shop safety techniques and will create two projects in addition to a variety of exercises. Class fee covers welding materials, gases, and metal for practice. Students may purchase metal from me (if needed) for their projects, at cost.

Directed Studio: Stone Carving

Learn how to meet the challenges of reductive sculpture by working with a piece of stone. Participants will discuss three-dimensional thinking, and will be taught how to use basic stone carving tools and techniques as well as safe studio practices. Some tools provided by the studio. Students will create a sculpture in alabaster or limestone.

Class Limit: Minimum 3, Maximum 6
Cost: \$225, plus individual expense for tools and stone
